Purpose of Report

Pursuant to 70 O.S. § 2120, the College of the Muscogee Nation submits the following to demonstrate its course of action for compliance with the requirements of this statute.

Campus Expression Policy

Individual students and student organizations shall be free to examine and to discuss all questions of interest to them, and to express opinions publicly and privately. They shall be free to support causes by orderly means that do not disrupt the regular and essential operation of the institution.

Students have the right to assemble, to select speakers, and to discuss issues of their choice. The College shall establish reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions to assure that the assembly does not substantially disrupt the work of the institution or interfere with the opportunity of other students to obtain an education or otherwise infringe upon the rights of others.

Professional Development for Students and Employees

The College of the Muscogee Nation communicates policy and expectations to students and employees through educational programming provided to the faculty, staff, and students, as well as publication of policies in their respective handbooks and on the CMN website. New policies and/or updates to existing policies may also be communicated throughout the year via electronic communication.

Barriers or Disruptions of Free Expression

The College of the Muscogee Nation did not experience any barriers or disruptions of free speech during the calendar year ending December 31, 2020.
