Accuplacer is a suite of computerized tests designed to evaluate students' skills in reading, English, and mathematics for placement in the appropriate courses. Accuplacer tests are computer-adaptive and were developed by the College Board, which also administers the ACT test. Student score reports are available immediately following testing. The assessment can be taken in the Student Success testing center, weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. CMN will specify which tests a student should take. The following policy applies to all students taking the ACCUPLACER assessment:

- 1. All examinations will be coordinated through the CMN Assessment Center and will cover the following areas: Reading, Math, and English skills.
- 2. Students will be allowed to take the exam (or each component) up to three times, unless the student has earned a regular grade or withdrawn with a "W" for the course.
- 3. Initial testing must be completed prior to enrollment and retesting must be completed within the first week of the trimester. Any changes in students schedule due to retesting must be processed during the first week of the trimester. No retesting will be allowed after the fifth day of the trimester.

## Proficiency requirements:

Students that do not meet the below requirements will be required to take remedial courses to remove their deficiencies.
