



TESTING RESOURCES FOR STUDENTS

ACCUPLACER is a computerized placement test used by the College of the Muscogee Nation to assess an incoming student's proficiency in reading, writing, English and mathematics. The CMN representative or proctor will specify which of the tests a student should take. Accuplacer tests are administered at the CMN Testing Center weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. No appointment necessary.

To prepare for testing, ACCUPLACER offers several learning tools that are designed to help students improve in areas where their academic performance may need improvement.
