## Tribal Leadership (24 Credit Hours)

The Tribal Leadership certificate program is a deep dive into the study of leadership theory and practice, Indigenous organizations, Indigenous politics, and hands-on community development meant to help equip and shape the next generation of Indigenous American leadership.
