Who is Eligible?

A high school junior and senior, age 16 and older, who meets the eligible requirements of an ACT/Pre-ACT composite score of 19 or SAT/PSAT of 990 or a GPA of 3.0.

Requirements

Concurrent students must have the approval of their high school and legal guardian, and must fulfill requirements for graduation. Home school or unaccredited high school students, must have enough credits to be classified as a junior or senior and meet the eligibility requirements as listed above.

Course Placements

In order to enroll, the concurrent student must earn an ACT score of 19 or higher in the subject they would like to enroll in. An ACT Score of 19 must be earned in Reading for enrollment in any courses other than Math or Science. For information regarding all other testing score placements, to schedule placement testing or to get practice test information, please contact ssc@cmn.edu

Course Workload

A concurrent student may register in college courses if they do not exceed 19 credit hours per term, combined with their high school courses (excluding non-academic courses such as Athletics, Band, etc.) To calculate, one-half high school unit is equivalent to 3 credit hours of college work. A high school schedule submission will be required to calculate course workload.
